Children, their Uniform and Equipment

We expect every child to be dressed in correct uniform, especially sensible black shoes. <u>Please note</u> that jewellery and make up are not allowed.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has the following equipment in school: PE Kit, reading book, pencil case (please include **a glue stick** and a **whiteboard pen**) – regularly checked and re-stocked.

Please check that labels are still present and readable on clothing items throughout the year.

Reading Records

All children should read daily at home and will start to receive reading books from next week. This can be the reading book from school, or their library book. Reading is not a race, it should be enjoyed; questions and 'book talk' is crucial in ensuring our children have understood what they have read. Children can change their library book every Wednesday.

You can always supplement your child's school reading book with something else: magazines, comics, classic books, non-fiction books, kindles and audio books.
