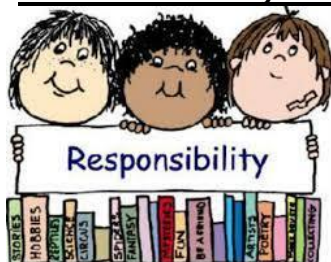

A responsibility involves having something expected of you.

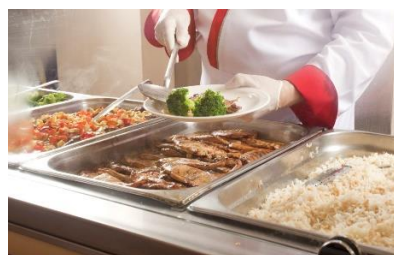
A responsibility might be a task you are expected to do.
