Dear Parents/carers,

Here are a few things your child must have with them **on their first day**. Please ensure that your child has:

- ✓ **Stationery must be in 1 pencil case:** including writing pens (blue ink), writing pencils, coloured pencils, rubber, sharpener, **pritt stick, 30cm ruler**, and a **whiteboard pen**. Make sure your items are clearly labelled.
- ✓ **PE Kit: St. Andrew's t-shirt, navy shorts, track suit bottoms (for winter) and trainers.** Include your name labelled inside your clothing.
- ✓ PE for Y6 is **Tuesdays and Thursdays**
- ✓ **Water bottle**
- ✓ **A small notebook for daily homework** – at the end of each day there will be some quick maths or some research to do that we will share during registration the following morning.
- ✓ **Our first Guided Reading Book will be 'Son of the Circus' – A Victorian Story by EL Norry.** It would be really useful if your child could buy a copy and bring it to school in September. You don't need to read it in advance.

Over the summer holiday you should try to keep the learning bubbling over.

- Keep up with your reading, read a range of books, preferably aloud to an audience.
- You still will have access to athletics so keep logging on.
- Please use Hit the Button to keep your number bonds to 100 and times tables alive
